He was disappointed with the Writing score. He doesn't seem to believe me that, according to what I have heard *directly* from admissions officers, colleges don't look at this score because they are not sure what it measures.

This is a tough call for me. I know what you mean: Georgetown explicitly says it does not care about this section. But here are some stats from Brown that could suggest that at least one competitive school like Brown DOES care about the Writing section.

As a student's Writing Score improves, so do his chances of admissions.

Who was it that said that statistics are like bikinis: "What they reveal is suggestive, but what they conceal is vital."

The reason I say that these statistics might not be conclusive is that they break down the scores by each of the 3 sections, and it doesn't say, really, what would happen in Henk's case if he applied with just these scores..... I would bet that the other 2 scores are so high that the Writing Score wouldn't matter that much.

I think what you could do is ask his college guidance advisor for his/her advice. I defer to him/her, and can we touch base after we hear his/her advice?
